In **Mt Shasta**, in the week leading up to us announcing we would close learning centers, Dawn had a feeling that we might close, so she decided to put together two weeks worth of packets for the Pine Grove students to take home on Thursday, just in case. As it turns out, that Sunday we decided to close the centers, so our students already had what they needed. I spent that week training teachers how to use Google Classroom and we practiced using both Zoom and Google Meet for classes. The second week of our closure, our staff in Mt Shasta spent time putting together lessons on Google classroom and preparing for regular online classes for the rest of the year.

I hope this week finds you well and taking time for self care. The sun is back out and spring is happening! Brace yourselves, this is a long one!

- 1) Big group Zoom meetings : Changed to Monday only 10:00am. (Acorns & Oak Leaf invited, not mandatory)
 - Focus on group concerns, how we are doing and what we have been working on at home. This coming Monday, David Walker, our school counselor, is invited to talk about self care and mental health during this time. David has been a great asset this year with the Oak Leaf social skills class. I'm sure our students will love to hear his kind and wise words. (pssst...he's also pretty funny!). Attached is a page David compiled for ESSENTIAL RESOURCES for Siskiyou County.
 - Small group meetings/lessons will happen with each grade level or individual tutoring. Look for emails from your child's teacher to schedule those.

2) Homeschool Packets- Pick up and drop off Monday 3/30

- Work for your child will be labeled in a bag on Mary's porch in the PICK UP bin.
 If you have anything to turn in, you can leave it in the TURN IN bin.
- Acorns & Oak Leaf- we have compiled QUITE A BIT of work for you! Parents-I expect you to dole it out as you see fit, or give them the packet to manage.
 Please don't feel stressed or overwhelmed, this can be an emotionally challenging time. Do the best you can! Call or email your teachers for help, if needed.
